

 "TEA requires all students to be in attendance 90% of the time a class is offered. Students who fail to meet the 90% requirement, will lose credit for the course. Any student who has 5 or more absences per semester in any course will lose credit for that course. During Virtual Instruction, students are required to participate in each day's courses no later than 11:59 PM in order to be marked present. Students must do one of the following in order to be counted present:



- 1. Interact in Google Classroom by answering daily questions, completing assignments, taking quizzes or tests, watching required videos, filling out google forms, etc.
- 2. Interact directly with a teacher by attending live Google Meets and/or Zooms, or other direct communication. These required interactions must occur in each scheduled class each day."



Students have <u>3 ways</u> in which to engage in the class in order to be counted present:

- Daily Progress in the Learning Management System -Student engages in anything on Google Classroom, watches pre-recorded lessons
- 2. Daily progress during teacher/student interaction attending Live instruction, interaction via office hours
- 3. Completion of tasks or Turn in assignments graded assignment, Google attendance form

Students have from 12:00 AM to 11:59 PM each day to interact in order to receive attendance credit.



# 90% Rule

Students MUST be counted present 90% or more days to receive credit for the course.

We are on an A/B Block Schedule; therefore, the maximum number of absences will be less than previous years.

- The fall semester has a total of 85 days (43 A days, 42 B days). A student will lose credit on the <u>5th absence</u> per class.
- The spring semester has a total of (45 A days, 44 B days). A student will **lose credit** on the **5th absence** per class.
