GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All FWISD high school students are working on the Distinguished Level of Achievement High School Graduation Plan

In rare cases, students may complete a "lesser" plan. These cases are rare, must be approved by the principal, and do not allow the student to attend a 4 year university after high school. Decisions to move to a different graduation plan are not made until a student's senior year.

EARNING HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT:

- Earn a passing grade
- Be present >90% days offered

ATTENDANCE

- Must be present 90% of days available
- Attendance is by class period NOT by day
- Can pass a class academically and lose credit due to excessive absences
- VOE Verification of Enrollment & ATTENDANCE form
 - Must have to obtain Driver License
 - Any denial of credit due to attendance prevents administrator from verifying information

ENDORSEMENTS:

- Multidisciplinary (Everyone, 4x4)
- Public Service (JROTC or Ed program)
- Arts & Humanities (4 years same fine art or 4 years language)
- Business & Industry (Ag, AAVTC, Business)

GRADE POINT AVERAGE:

WEIGHTED GRADE POINT AVERAGE BEGINNING WITH THE CLASS OF 2023

The District categorizes and weights courses as Tier I, Tier II, and Tier III in accordance with policy EIC (LOCAL). The Weighted GPA is used to determine local graduation honors and the highest ranking graduate.

Tier I courses include Advanced Placement (AP) courses, International Baccalaureate (IB) courses, dual credit courses, any courses for which a Tier I course is a prerequisite, and other rigorous District-designated courses.

Tier II courses include high school Pre-AP courses, Pre-IB courses, and other courses locally designated as honor courses.

Tier III courses include all other courses not designated as Tier I or Tier II courses.

The District converts semester grade points and calculates a weighted GPA in accordance with the following chart:


CLASS RANK:

- FORT WORTH ISD IS CHANGING THE WAY CLASS RANK IS CALCULATED.
- BEGINNING WITH STUDENTS IN THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 2024, CLASS RANK WILL BE DETERMINED USING THE 16 HIGHEST NUMERIC COURSE GRADES IN THE HIGHEST WEIGHTED CATEGORIES IN THE FOLLOWING:
 - FOUR COURSES (8 SEMESTERS) IN MATH
 - FOUR COURSES (8 SEMESTERS) IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS
 - FOUR COURSES (8 SEMESTERS) IN SCIENCE
 - FOUR COURSES (8 SEMESTERS) IN SOCIAL STUDIES

COLLEGE CREDIT OPTIONS:

- AP Advanced Placement; students must earn a 3 or higher on the AP exam for MOST colleges to award credit. Each college has their own requirements. Students should research this to determine the score their desired college will require.
- <u>Dual Credit</u> collaboration with TCC. Pass course, get TCC credit.
- On Ramps collaboration with UT Austin. "Dual Enrollment" College professor and an AHHS teacher. 2 grades. Have option to "decline" college credit.





- AHHS strives for Bs or better grades in every class for all Freshman Students.
- Research by University of Chicago shows "students who earn a 3.0 GPA or above in high school have at least a 50 percent chance of graduating from a four-year college within six years" (Practice Driven Data, p. 32).



Freshman Success: Get Involved!


 Currently, 369 freshman students (68%) are participating in at least one extra curricular activity

Students who participate in extra curricular activities:

- Analyzing Bs or better data: 74% of Bs or better are held by students who are involved at AHHS
- Analyzing attendance data: students who participate in extra curricular activities have an average attendance of 93% compared to 88% for students who do not participate in extra curricular activities
